

18 Days of Prayer and Fasting January 2018

3rd to 7th January 2018

Day 1: 3/01/2018- Thanksgiving

1 Chronicles 16:34. Give thanks to the Lord, for he is good; his love endures forever.

Prayer Points

- Thank God for the gift of life and a fresh start. He has enabled us to see 2018.
- Thank God for taking care of our families in the year 2017.
- Thank God for His attributes and this far that He has brought us. **Psalm 34:1**
- Thank God for many things he has done in our lives. (Mention what he has done for you specifically). To the extent of giving His only son to die for us. **John 3:16**

Day 2: 4/01/2018- A call to repentance

Joel 2: 12-13. Even now, declares the Lord, return to me with all your heart, with fasting and weeping and mourning. Rend your heart and not your garments. Return to the Lord your God, for he is gracious and compassionate, slow to anger and abounding in love, and he relents from sending calamity.

Prayer points

- Pray for forgiveness of sins you have committed knowingly or unknowingly. **Psalm 24:1-3**
- Pray for forgiveness on behalf of your family members (mention them by name). **Job 1:4-5**
- Repent on behalf of the Nation and the Body of Christ. **Esther 4:14, Gal 5:16-18**
- Pray that God will break any generational curses that may be attached your family.
- May we as the body of Christ be sensitive to the move of God through the outpouring of the Holy Spirit in this season.

Day 3: 5/01/2018 - Seeking God and His righteousness

Mathew 6:33. But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well.

Prayer Points

- Pray that Jesus will cleanse His temple inside out for the glory of his Name.
- Pray that we will seek God first in all our ways as individuals and families
- Pray that all family members will connect to the Lord by surrendering their life's to Him.
- Pray that we will be Christ like in all our dealings and that everything we will do will be for his glory.

Day 4: 6/01/2018 - Praying for God's provision

Philippians 4:19. And my God will meet all your needs according to the riches of his glory in Christ Jesus.

Prayer Points

- Pray that God will provide for all our needs according to his riches in glory in Christ Jesus.
- Pray that God will provide for the homeless, widows and orphans.
- Pray that God will bless our jobs and businesses.
- Pray that God will provide school fees/needs for our children.

Day 5: 7/01/2018 - Protection

Psalm 91

Prayer Points

- Pray that God will protect us against diseases. Deut 7:15
- Pray that God will protect the youth from drug abuse and engaging in sexual immorality.
- Pray that God will protect us from premature deaths.

Day 6: 8/01/2018 – Marriages

Ephesians 5:31 “For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh.”

Prayer points

- Pray that husbands will love their wives unconditionally. *Ephesians 5:25 – Husbands, love your wives, just as Christ loved the church and gave himself up for her.*
- Pray that God will help husbands and wives to take their responsibilities in marriage.
- Pray that wives will be submissive to their husbands. *Ephesians 5:22- Wives, submit yourselves to your own husbands as you do to the Lord.*
- Pray that couples will be faithful to each other.
- Pray that children will obey their parents. *Ephesians 6: 1- children obey your parents in the Lord, for this is right.*

Day 7: 9/01/2018 - Salvation

Ephesians 2:8. For it is by grace you have been saved, through faith—and this is not from yourselves, it is the gift of God.

Prayer points

- Pray that God will grant salvation to the family members who have not yet received Christ as their personal saviour.
