Day 1: Individual

SUN 8TH

Romans 8:31: What shall we then say to these things? If God be for us, who can be against us?

- Declare because God is for us, we are TRIUMPHANT....in all that we do.
- Confess and repent about those instances you felt and thought God had abandoned you.
- Pray that we will be careful to let God take charge of every situation in our lives this year for the battle belongs to Him.

Day 2: Church leadership

MON 9TH

Romans 8:33: Who shall lay anything to the charge of God's elect? It is God that justifieth.

- Thank the Lord for our Pastors, Deacons and Leader in all positions for they are Gods elect.
- Confess and repent for taking leadership lightly i.e forgetting they are Gods elect.
- Pray that no weapon that is fashioned against their positions in church shall prosper.

Day 4: Church

WED 11TH

- Declare that the Lords plans & purposes for the church will prevail
- Confess and repent of any wrong doing, false dependencies, misplaced ideas and loss of spiritual passion in our church
- Pray that we realize that our inheritance and hope as a church family is in God's incomparable and incredible great power which is available and at work within us

Day 5: Nation

THUR 12TH

Jeremiah 29:7 – Also, seek the peace and prosperity of the city to which I have carried you into exile. Pray to the LORD for it, because if it prospers, you too will prosper.
